OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Team Guidelines

- Sponsorships will be available for a max of six teams with six members each.
- Team sponsors are responsible for recruiting their team.
- Teams will be accepted on a first come-first served basis.
- Each team is required to staff their station throughout the entire event, including clean-up.
- All items must be removed immediately following the event.

- Chili team name
- Contact information for Sponsor / Team Captain and each member
- Vector logo for signage and collateral

Chili Guidelines

- **Bring your best chili!** Chili is defined as any type of meat or combination of meat cooked with chili peppers, in addition to other spices and ingredients, as desired. We will also accept vegetarian chili.
- Ingredients must be pre-cooked and prepared in advance of the event (e.g., chili is delivered "ready to eat").
- Contestants must supply all materials needed for preparation, serving (including sauces, toppings, condiments, etc.) and clean-up. *Disposable serving cups and utensils will be provided.*
- Team must prepare a total of 8 gallons of chili for guests and judges to taste.

Competition Guidelines

JUDGING PANEL

- Judges will taste each chili and select the winner.
- The judges' decision will be final, based on scorecards.
- Each team will present their chili to the panel of judges for tasting.
Teams can include condiments, sides, decorative bowls, etc to enhance their presentation.

SCORING CRITERIA

- Texture
- Flavor
- Consistency
- Spice & Seasonings
- Aroma
- Color

Winner will be selected from attendee voting, one ticket per guest.
